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From the Editorial's Desk

In today's dynamic regulatory environment, success is defined not just by approvals, but by the ability to consistently deliver precision, reliability, and scientific excellence. As the industry continues to evolve, the importance of high-quality regulatory data and structured documentation has become more critical than ever.

This edition of our newsletter captures the outcomes of the **473rd Registration Committee meeting held on 29.06.2026**, bringing together the approved and satisfactory cases across every registration category, along with the policy developments that will shape the coming quarter for the agrochemical and bio-pesticide industry.

The meeting recorded an exceptionally heavy formulation cycle, with **1,780 applications under Section 9(4) FIM** scrutinised and found satisfactory – the largest volume in recent meetings. The technical segment was equally active: **59 applications under Section 9(4) TIM** were approved for indigenous manufacture and **20 technical import cases under Section 9(4) TI** were cleared. On the innovation side, **14 cases under Section 9(3)** secured registration, including several first-in-country combination fungicides and herbicides, while **53 bio-pesticide applications** of already registered strains were found satisfactory.

Key Regulatory Developments – 473rd RC

Paraquat Dichloride & Carbosulfan: The RC perused and extensively deliberated the report of the Expert Review Committee constituted under the chairmanship of Dr. Debasisa Mohanty, noting that the deliberations were made in terms of the consultation process under Section 27(2) of the Insecticides Act, 1968. Its recommendations are being communicated separately to the Government of India for a final view, which the RC will then implement.

9(4) FIM – conditions for issue of CRs: For satisfactory cases, certificates of registration will be issued only after KYC compliance of the applicant account and submission of the original affidavit in the format prescribed in the 439th RC, forwarded by the authorised signatory within 15 days of uploading of the minutes. The RC also directed strict adherence to Gazette Notification SO 3951(E) dated 08.08.2018 while issuing approvals.

These outcomes reflect a deeper capability – managing complex regulatory pathways, generating robust stability and efficacy data, and aligning with stringent and evolving guidelines. It is this capability that enables consistent and timely approvals.

At JDR, we believe that true leadership lies in setting benchmarks – through accuracy, attention to detail, and scientific rigor. As we move ahead, our focus remains on driving regulatory excellence, supporting our partners, and contributing to the advancement of the industry at large.

Chemical Cases under 9(3) TI, TIM, FI, FIM

The 9(3) segment was the innovation highlight of this meeting, with fourteen cases approved – nine formulations for indigenous manufacture (FIM), four technicals for indigenous manufacture (TIM) and one technical import (TI). Several first-in-country combination fungicides and herbicides secured registration. Applications for Bensulfuron-Methyl Technical, Ipconazole 40.70% FS and Myclobutanil Technical were held back for mutagenicity data, clarification of the formulator's address and chemical equivalence respectively, reflecting continued strict regulatory scrutiny.

Chemical Cases under 9(4) TI, FI

The 9(4) TI segment reflects a complete approval trend, with all 20 applications granted registration, indicating strong regulatory support for technical imports. Every approved source is a Chinese manufacturer, highlighting continued dependence on global supply chains for key active ingredients. Repeat molecules – notably Emamectin Benzoate, Imazethapyr, Carbendazim, Cartap Hydrochloride and Oxyfluorfen – were imported by several companies, ensuring wider availability in the domestic market. No case was approved under 9(4) FI in this meeting. All approvals are subject to submission of the original consent letter, ICAMA certificate and geo-tagging documents from the source.

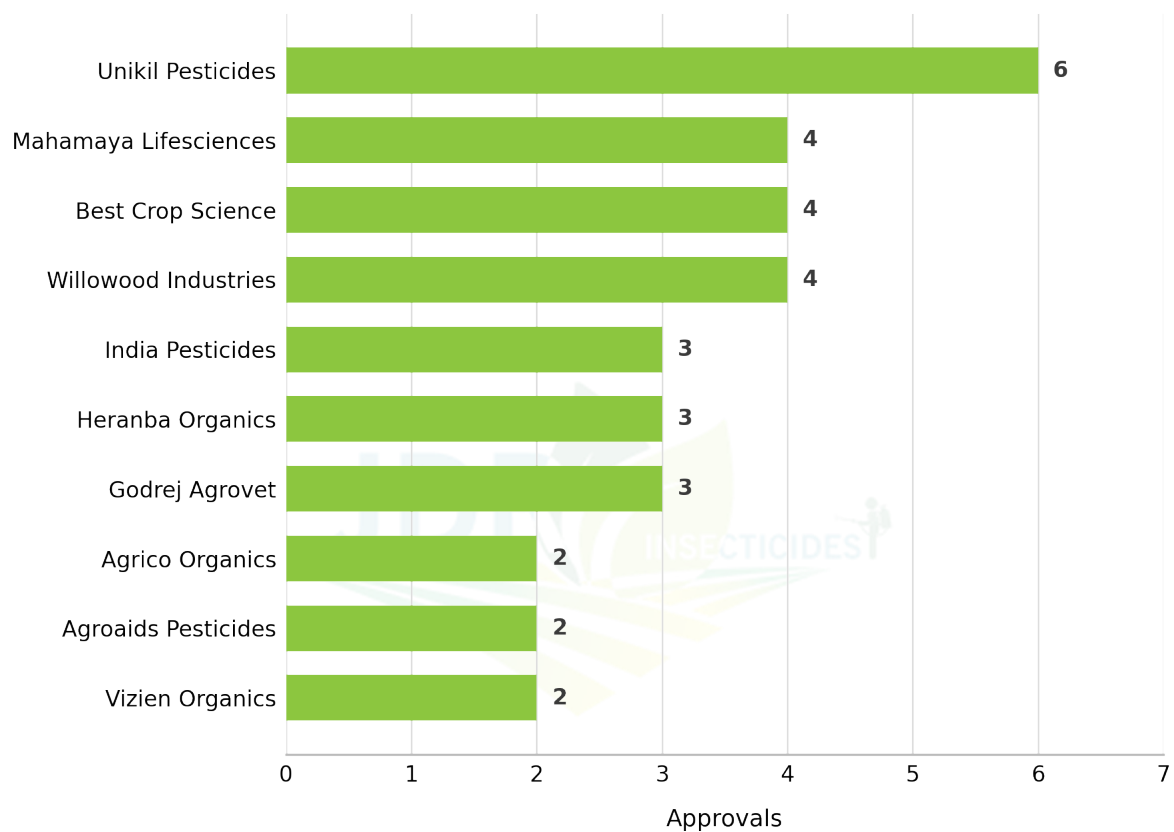
Chemical Cases under 9(4) TIM

The 9(4) TIM segment was the busiest technical cycle of the year, with all 59 applications for technical indigenous manufacture approved. The list spans a diverse range of molecules – herbicides, fungicides and insecticides – with repeated entries for Dimethomorph, Saflufenacil, Mesotrione, Penoxsulam, Pyraclostrobin, Propaquizafop, Haloxypop R Methyl Ester, Difenoconazole, Spiromesifen, Thiophanate Methyl and Cyazofamid, signalling a clear shift towards domestic manufacture of off-patent actives.

Chemical Cases under 9(3) Biopesticides

Fifty-four applications of already registered strains of bio-pesticides were placed before the Committee under Section 9(3); 53 were found satisfactory and are listed below, while one application was rejected on account of a non-satisfactory potency test result. Registrations are concentrated around a few key microbial products, with *Pseudomonas fluorescens* 1% WP leading clearly, followed by *Verticillium chlamydosporium* 1% WP and *Pseudomonas fluorescens* 2.0% AS. The trend highlights the increasing industry focus on bio-based crop protection solutions, particularly bacteria and fungi-based products aimed at sustainable agriculture and soil health management.

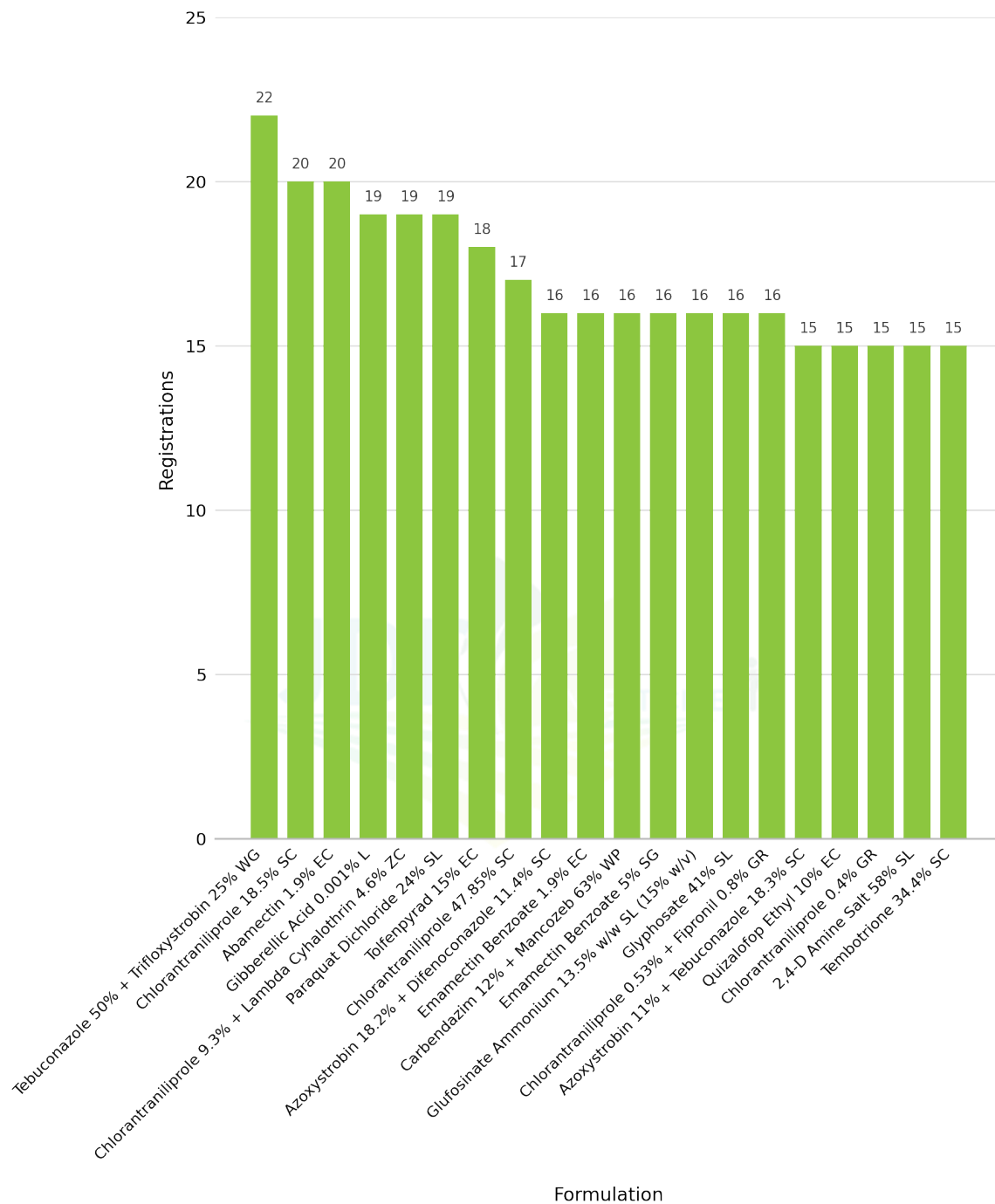

Chemical Cases under 9(4) FIM

A total of 1,780 applications were received online for grant of registration under Formulation Indigenous Manufacture (FIM), Section 9(4); all 1,780 were scrutinised and found satisfactory – the heaviest formulation cycle of the year. Combination fungicides lead the ranking, with Tebuconazole 50% + Trifloxystrobin 25% WG recording the highest number of registrations, followed by Chlorantraniliprole-based formulations, which appear repeatedly across the top ranks, and by broad-spectrum herbicides such as Paraquat Dichloride and Glyphosate. The pattern indicates sustained market demand for high-efficacy, broad-spectrum and multi-target products. The table below lists the top 20 most registered formulations of this meeting.
